Laying the foundation stone in Lübeck: Dräger constructs new production and logistics building

Lübeck – Today, Dräger laid the foundation stone for its new production and logistics building. Around 150 Infrastructure Projects employees from Lübeck-Travemünde and 40 Interservices GmbH employees will move to the new premises on Revalstrasse at the Lübeck site. The amount to be invested is about EUR 12 million.

The new complex is being constructed on the 11,000 sqm site, providing optimum conditions for improving logistics and production processes. Planning envisages a highly flexible and transparent building design. Production will be more closely connected to administrative and planning functions. In addition, operating costs of the new building are lower than in the currently rented property. “The new building sends out a clear signal about our commitment to the Lübeck site and is an investment in the future intended to cut costs and therefore secure the long-term future of jobs in Lübeck,” emphasizes Stefan Dräger, CEO of Drägerwerk Verwaltungs AG.

The rapidly growing Infrastructure Projects business field plans, installs and maintains central supply systems and media supply systems for hospitals. The new building has 9,400 sqm total floor space, divided into 3,800 sqm production area, 2,700 sqm warehouse and 2,900 sqm office and recreational space. Production will move into the new premises in December 2010. Construction will be completed in March 2011.
